

## Statistics on In Vitro Fertilization

The number of children that were either frozen or killed through the process of *in vitro* fertilization is not readily available. The Society for Assisted Reproductive Technologies (SART), which accounts for more than 90% of the existing fertility clinics in the United States, supplies a [basic summary](#) of success rates compiled from data obtained from their participating fertility clinics. The information that we are given consists of the number of IVF cycles broken down by the age of the participants along with things such as live birth rate per embryo transfer, number of twins/triplets, and whether or not the embryos used in that cycle were frozen, fresh, or produced from a donated egg.

One analysis of data compiled by SART suggests that between 790,000 and 1,100,000 children died or were consigned to freezers as a result of IVF in 2012.

Others are not so “optimistic”.

Projecting the average growth of 5% each year, our nation will permit 191,207 cycles of IVF treatment. Each of these cycles will on average involve the creation of 20 children.

Optimistically, 2 out of these 20 children might be chosen for implantation and might survive, and the survival (or implantation) rate is less than 40%.

When you stretch the math out you come up with roughly 3,441,730 children being killed each year as a direct result of the practice of IVF, whether it be through the “unintended” death of those not strong enough to survive the process, or through the intended destruction of those no longer needed to complete the process. Even granting the possibility that the number of IVF cycles done each year did not change from 2012-2015, we would still come up with a best case scenario of 2,973,096 children dead as a direct result of the practice of IVF.

In addition to this, according to some in the embryo adoption industry, there are currently over 600,000 human beings in frozen storage in the United States alone, most of which will be “destroyed” for lack of adoptive parents.
